The purpose of this correspondence is to acknowledge receipt of your correspondence dated June 7, 2007, requesting a meeting between you and Agency staff to discuss the April 2, 2007, letter. The April 2 letter you referenced is the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Pacific Regional Director's decision on your Notice of Appeal dated November 10, 2006, filed pursuant to 25 Code of Regulations (CFR) Part 2, from the decision dated November 6, 2006, of the Superintendent, Bureau of Indian Affairs, Central California Agency.

We regret to inform you that the Agency will be unable to meet and discuss with you the issues involving the membership and organization of the California Valley Miwok Tribe (Tribe), due to your appeal of the April 2, 2007, decision of the Pacific Regional Director, to the Interior Board of Indian Appeals (IBIA).

Since your appeal is now before the IBIA, the BIA has no authority to take any further action until the IBIA issues an order or decision.
