ORDER

Having reviewed and considered the “Joint Status Report Regarding the Status of the Reconsidered Decision of the Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs and Motion for Extension of the Temporary Stay of Litigation” filed by the Plaintiffs and Defendants in this case, it is hereby ORDERED that the Motion for Extension of the Temporary Stay of Litigation is GRANTED.

It is hereby FURTHER ORDERED that:

1. This matter is stayed until August 15, 2011.
2. Defendants shall not be required to file a responsive pleading to the Complaint until further Order of this Court.
3. Any applicable deadline for the issuance of a scheduling order under Rule 16(b), Fed. R. Civ. P., is stayed pending further Order of this Court.
4. In the event the Assistant Secretary does not issue his reconsidered decision by August 15, the voluntary temporary stay of litigation is lifted and this Court shall set deadlines for the Defendants’ responsive pleading to the Complaint.
5. The parties shall file a joint status report no later than August 15, 2011.

6. Either Plaintiffs or Defendants may request that the stay be lifted prior to August 15, 2011 in the event that the defendant Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs of the United States Department of the Interior issues his reconsidered decision with regard to his December 22, 2010 Decision prior to August 15, 2011.
